Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions apply to all cruise holidays and general charter of any vessel or tender operated by The Great Escape Charter Company unless otherwise agreed in writing and signed by all parties. No agent or representative has any authority to vary or omit any part or all of these conditions.

Reserve your place

You can make your reservation by calling, faxing or emailing our reservation team in Broome. We will hold a tentative reservation for you for 21 days pending receipt of a 20% non-refundable deposit and completed reservation form.

The payment of deposit secures your place and the signed reservation form is acknowledgement that you have read, understood and agree to the booking conditions available with The Great Escape Charter Company. We will confirm your reservation to you in writing on receipt of your deposit payment. Two 20% part payments will be due 4 months and 6 months after initial deposit is paid. The balance of your fare is due to be received by us 8 weeks before departure. For reservations made within 8 weeks, full fare is required immediately. If any payments are not received by due date, The Great Escape Charter Company reserves the right to refuse boarding.

Cancellation

As we must make firm reservations for each client, it is necessary for us to strictly enforce our cancellation policies.

If you cancel a reservation anytime prior to the departure of your confirmed Escape, the following penalties will apply:

Notification Period	Cancellation Penalty
24 weeks	Loss of deposit
12-24 weeks	50% of total costs
Less than 8 weeks	100% of total costs

All cancellations must be advised to us in writing. Please note we strongly recommend you take out comprehensive travel insurance that will cover you against these penalties in the event of having to cancel your Escape due to unforeseen circumstances. We would be happy to assist you with this.

Changes to Itinerary

The Kimberley is a rugged region subject to 12 metre tides.

No two Kimberley Adventures are ever exactly the same. Whilst your adventure will be very similar to the itinerary provided, Mother Nature will affect the itinerary.

We plan each day according to the tides and often rearrange to accommodate this. Your Captain will discuss the next day's activities and adventures most evenings; this is your opportunity to further customise the itinerary to suit you.

Insurance

We strongly recommend that you purchase travel insurance to cover you against such things as personal illness or accident, cancellation, loss of baggage etc.

The Great Escape Charter Company can recommend a policy for you. If you choose not to take travel insurance, then The Great Escape Charter Company will require a signed and dated letter stating that this is your preference.

Baggage

All guests travelling on a Southern Kimberley Experience or A Taste of the Kimberley will receive a complimentary travel bag.

This will be provided with your final documents approximately 4 weeks prior to departure.

It is imperative that the specially provided bags be used on your Escape. Given the use of small aircraft, luggage is restricted to a maximum of 10kg per person.

Personal Navigation Systems

Please be aware that Personal Navigation and GPS Systems are NOT permitted onboard any of our vessels at anytime.

Travelling Alone

For those single travellers requiring twin share, we will endeavour to match you with a same sex travelling companion.

However, as the vast majority of our single travellers prefer their own single accommodation, a single supplement fee will be charged, cabin rate less 20%, and if we are able to provide a companion to share with, the supplement will be refunded.

Price Guarantee

Rising fuel prices and increased costs can sometime mean an increased holiday cost, however we guarantee that once your full fare has been received by The Great Escape Charter Company there will be no increase in the cost of your Escape. We will absorb any increase. So book and pay as early as possible to guarantee your price. Should fuel prices continue to rise, the prices will be adjusted to reflect this change, except where full prepayment has been received prior to the price increases.
